Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital (ZSFG), Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences, is offering a non-paid 24 to 40 hours/week neuropsychology postdoctoral position beginning September 2021 through June 2022. Postdoctoral Fellows will be trained in the comprehensive use of neuropsychological and personality assessment measures and will perform neuropsychological and psychological evaluations on an inpatient and outpatient basis with patients referred from within the hospital and from San Francisco Public Health Clinics.

ZSFG is a public health hospital that serves low income and diverse ethnic and racial minority populations. It is a teaching hospital for the University of California-San Francisco School of Medicine. This experience in Clinical Neuropsychology includes access to a full range of psychiatric inpatients, ambulatory and hospitalized medical patients, including consultation with Neurology, Neurosurgery, General Medicine and Inpatient Psychiatry Services. Weekly individual supervision, case conferences, and didactic clinical seminars are offered. Additionally, interns will have the opportunity to participate in a neurosurgical rotation that includes experiences such as a neurosurgical observation, and various traumatic brain injury clinics. Weekly neuro-autopsy/brain-cutting seminars are also available to our fellows. Potential for future or program improvement research may be available.

Qualifications: Applicants must have earned a Ph.D. or Psy.D. in clinical psychology from an APA accredited program with APA standing at the time the degree was awarded. Individuals who have completed all the necessary course work and predoctoral internship requirements for such a doctoral program, but who are in the process of completing their dissertations, will also be considered. The applicant must have completed course work in both personality and neuropsychological assessment. Ethnic minority and bilingual applicants are strongly encouraged to apply.

Application Process: Application deadline is January 11, 2020. Applicants should send a letter of interest, a curriculum vita, three letters of reference, and copies of one neuropsychological assessment report and one personality assessment report to:
