The UCSF Trauma Recovery Center (TRC)/Rape Treatment Center (RTC) is part of the Division of Trauma Recovery Services (DTRS) in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital (DPBS; ZSFG). The UCSF TRC is an internationally recognized program whose model of care has been codified into legislation and is being replicated across California and nationally.

The UCSF TRC provides short-term, trauma-focused therapy and comprehensive clinical case management services to adult survivors of interpersonal violence. Our work is grounded in the principles of social justice, cultural humility, and anti-racist clinical practice.
