Who we are: UCSF Trauma Recovery Center

The UCSF TRC is an internationally recognized program whose model of care has been codified into legislation and is being replicated across California and nationally. It is a program that is part of the Division of Trauma Recovery Services (DTRS) in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital (DPBS; ZSFG).

The UCSF TRC provides evidence-based, short-term, trauma-focused therapy and comprehensive clinical case management services to adult survivors of interpersonal violence. The TRC serves interpersonal violence survivors including crime survivors, immigrant survivors of persecution or torture (Survivors International Program), as well as community members who have an acquired traumatic brain injury (TBI; Neurotrauma Outreach Program (NTO)). All of our work is grounded in the principles of social justice, cultural humility, and anti-racist clinical practice.

Our clinicians provide comprehensive assessments, short-term, evidence-based/evidence informed, trauma-focused psychotherapy, assertive outreach (including community and home visits), and comprehensive case management services.

This position will work closely with other San Francisco agencies supporting AAPI communities, conducting community engagement and outreach about TRC services.
